At the conclusion of each year, credits are awarded for each course completed with a passing grade and according to the following guidelines: full-time/full-year course = one credit; fulltime/semester course $=0.50$ credit; full-time/quarter course $=0.25$ credit; part-time/full-year or semester course $=$ between 0.25 and 0.50 credits. Courses taken for one trimester only $=0.33$ credit and for two trimesters $=0.66$ credit.

A minimum of 26 credits is required for graduation. Students must also complete 20 hours of community service throughout their 4 years of high school.
